### **Our Camp Philosophy**

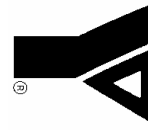

All players will be exposed to all aspects of the game.

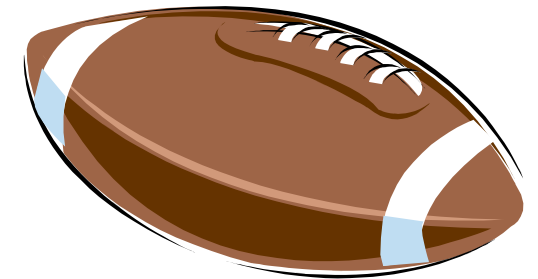

## Camp Staff / Directors



Our camp will be run by the coaches who coach in the Ragsdale YMCA Tackle Football program:

**Kevin Connolly** will be the Head Coach of the 9-10 Red team this coming fall. He has been a head coach in the Ragsdale YMCA program for 6 seasons and has coached in every age group. His teams have twice qualified for the CPFL Division I Playoffs. Of the original group of kids he coached up through the program from 2004-2007, 29 played high school or middle school football in 2009.

**Ray Carney** will be the Head Coach of the 2010 11-12 Gold Team this coming fall. (He was previously 11-12 Red Team Head Coach). Ray is starting his 1st season as a youth football coach, 8th coaching the Ragsdale YMCA program and 7th as a head coach. His teams won CPFL division championships in 2008 and 2009 and were CPFL Division II Champions in 2006 and 2007. Ray's primary goal is to teach players the skills and work ethic needed to prepare them for the next level.

**James Raleigh** will be the Head Coach of the 7-8 Gold team this fall. He was an assistant coach on the 2008 7-8 Gold team that won the CPFL Western Division Championship. He was an All-Conference Defensive Back in High School. He is a veteran youth sports coach with over 15 years experience coaching a variety of sports and age groups. He has extensive football coaching experience at the Youth, Middle, and High School levels.

**Lamar Boykin** has coached for 5 years for the Ragsdale organization. He was a 4 year starter for Guilford College and holds one of the all time interception records. Currently he is the middle school coach for High Point Christian. Lamar's focus is building Christian character, developing sound fundamentals, and total preparation for next level football.

**Darryl Cheeley** will be coaching the 9-10 Gold Team this coming fall. This is Darryl's third year as a coach in the Ragsdale YMCA Tackle program. His teams were CPFL Division I Champions in 2008 and CPFL Western Division Champions in 2009.

**Richard Hendley** will be the Head Coach of the 11-12 Red Team in 2010. (He was he Head Coach of the 11-12 Red Team in 2009). Richard will be entering his 5<sup>th</sup> season as a Head Coach in the Ragsdale YMCA program. His teams have qualified for the CPFL play-offs in 3 of his first 4 seasons. Richard played collegiately at Clemson University and in the National Football League with the Atlanta Falcons.

#### RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LEGAL LIABILITY

THIS IS YOUR RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY (the "Release"). You individually and/or on behalf of any minor child, release the YMCA of Greensboro, Inc., its officers, directors, board members, employees, volunteers, agents, independent contractors, other participants and/or others acting on its behalf (collectively, "YMCA"). You agree that this Release is effective immediately. This is important to you and/or any minor children, so do not sign until you have had your questions answered. You provide this Release freely, and without duress under the following terms:

- 1) GENERAL RELEASE: I hereby agree for myself and/or my child and our respective heirs, assigns and legal representatives, to indemnify, defend and hold YMCA and its officers, directors, board members, employees, volunteers, agents, independent contractors and other participants ("Release") in the program harmless from any and all claim and causes of action of any nature for any nature for any and all personal injury or illness, including death, which may occur to me and/or my child or which may be aggravated during or by any activity during the course of the program in which I have decided to allow myself and/or my child to engage. I further waive any and all claims or causes of action, which I and/or my child may now or hereafter have against Releases which may at any time arise as a result of any act or thing occurring in or arising out of my and/or my child's participation in the program. I further expressly understand and agree the foregoing indemnity, release and waiver is intended to be as broad and inclusive as permitted by the law of the State of North Carolina and that any portion thereof is held invalid, it is agreed that the balance shall, notwithstanding, continue in full force and effect.
- 2) ASSUMPTION OF RISK: I, individually and/or on behalf of any minor child, expressly and specifically assume any and all risk of injury, illness, death, or property damage resulting from my YMCA activities. You assume the risks: I, individually and on behalf of my minor child, understand that YMCA activities are strenuous and dangerous and should be engaged in only by persons in good health. I understand that I should consult a physician before enrolling myself and/or my child in the YMCA program. Once you sign, you are saying that you understand the risks involved and accept all of the risks.
- 3) MEDICAL RELEASE: I, individually and/or on behalf of any minor child, further hereby release YMCA from any claim whatsoever which may arise as a result of any first aid, treatment, or services or assistance provided to me in connection with any injury that arises from activities at YMCA. A) I take full responsibility for my and my child(s) welfare and safety on or at YMCA activities. B) I hereby give permission for emergency medical treatment to be administered as deemed appropriate.
- 4) INSURANCE: YOU ARE EXPECTED TO HAVE YOUR OWN HEALTH INSURANCE. You should understand that the YMCA does not carry insurance to cover injuries and losses that may befall you.
- 5) PHOTOGRAPHIC RELEASE: I consent to be photographed and to allow YMCA's use of any photos of myself and/or my minor child at its sole discretion.
