POOL RULES

1. Please shower before entering the pool
2. No Running or horseplay
3. No profanity or use of foul language
4. No diapers allowed in the pool, only swim diapers are allowed in the pool
5. All children under the age of 9 must be directly supervised by an adult; ages 10-12 may swim without an adult if they have passed the swim test and have a yellow band; 13-16 may swim without an adult in the pool area, but must have an adult in the facility
6. Swimmers wearing floating device must be accompanied by an adult who is in the water; no inflatable flotation devices will be allowed, including water wings/swim suits with built in floatation devices
7. There will be no food or drink allowed in the pool area, including glass wear
8. All swimmers must be wearing a bathing suit, no exceptions
9. Admission to the pool will be denied to all person's with open wounds, contagious diseases, or infectious diseases
10. Staff can not be responsible for valuables, includes paging devices
11. All swimmers are asked to respect the rights of others, please refrain from displays of public affection
12. The lifeguard has total discretion with whether or not toys, balls, noodles, etc, will be allowed in the pool area
13. Kickboards, masks, fins, and snorkels are to be used by lap swimmers only
14. All lap swimmers will be required to circle swim when necessary
15. For safety reasons there will be no talking to the lifeguards except for clarifications of rules or other safety reasons; please make all lengthy inquiries to the aquatics director
16. The lifeguard has total discretion in determining what is unsafe in the pool area
17. Use feet first entry at all sides of the pool except for the deep end
18. The lifeguard on duty has the authority to enforce these rules and remove those in violation from the pool area
